VANISHING POINT: WHERE SPECIES MEET

25 July to 25 August Daily, 7.30am to 6.30pm Free  
Vanishing Point is a performance-based video installation by artist team  
Snæbjörnsdóttir/ Wilson, who have a multidisciplinary, international  
practice. Their projects use art as a tool of disruption and mediation, to  
prompt new ecological perspectives in the face of growing environmental  
crisis. This three-**screen film installation in front of the Cathedral's High  
Altar** follows a ritualistic sharing of food – a **'breaking of bread' between  
species**, at a bespoke table.

The walls of the Song School are covered with the murals of Phoebe  
Traquair. Painted over a four-year period from 1888-1892, the murals  
illustrate a hymn of praise by all creation (*Benedicite Omnia Opera*).

Tours meet at the Cathedral entrance (Palmerston Place).
